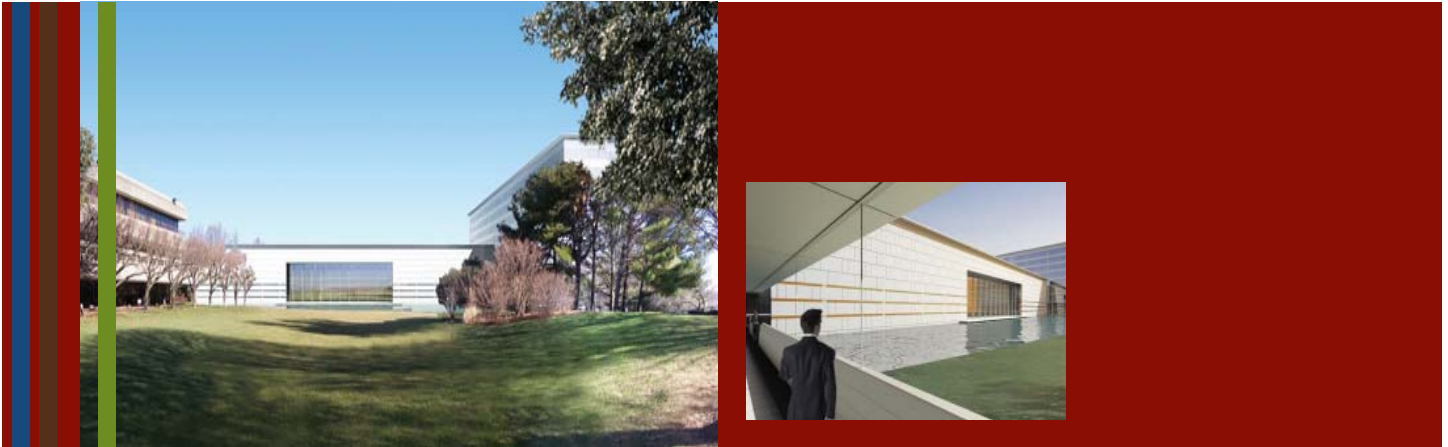


CENTER FOR LEADERSHIP EXCELLENCE Bethesda, MD



The Lockheed Martin Corporation is building a new home for their Center for Leadership Excellence, which is currently housed in leased space near the corporate headquarters in Bethesda. The new building is on LMCO property adjacent to the headquarters building. The new facility houses a 240 seat auditorium, a large two story classroom and conference center wing, structured parking and a 183 room business hotel. The building is being designed in the Washington Office of Leo A. Daly Associates.
